



Welcome	Maths

This will include work on: factor pairs, multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100, also multiplying/ dividing 2 and 3 digit numbers by one digit</p> <p>The next unit will cover topics about Length and Peimeter.</p> <p>We will then learn about Fractions, covering topics of equivalent fractions, improper fractions, mixed numbers and fracitons of amounts.</p> <p>Our last unit will be Decimals and lessons will cover the use of tenths , hundredths and division of any numbers by 10 and 100.</p>
English	Foundation subjects summary
<p><u>Term 3</u></p> <p>We will be using the story of The Three Billy Goats Gruff in our lessons.</p>  <p>The first part of the term will be Non-Fiction, looking at the use of subordinate clauses in instuctions.</p> <p>In the Fiction Module we will then re-write the story in an alternative genre.</p>	<p>In Science, we will be looking at ‘Magnets, States of Matter and the Water Cycle’ in T3 and in T4, the topic will be ‘Bio-organisms and Eco-systems’, which is looking at plants, seed dispersal and environmental changes.</p> <p>In Geography, we will be learning about Europe with a focus on trade-links and distribution of natural resources. Then in T4, we will be studying Ancient Egypt in our History lessons. In Design and Technology, we will design structures and in Art we will focus on Egyptian printing.</p> <p>In our RE lessons, we will be learning about Creation with a focus on what Christians can learn from the Creation Story and then in T4, we will focus on Easter.</p> <p>Our PE focus will be Hockey and Gymnastics in T3 and then in T4, we will be having Basketball with Matt and Dance lessons.</p> <p>In PSHE, we will learn about Dreams and Goals and in T4 the focus is ‘Healthy Me’.</p>
