Our first Maths focus will be on Place value within 20 – ensuring that we are confident with our teen numbers being 1 ten and several ones.

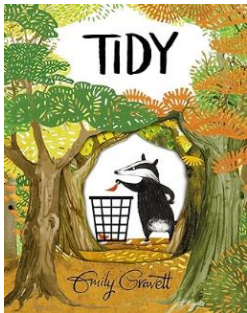
We will then move on to using this knowledge working on addition and subtraction to 20 – using our number bond knowledge to 10 to help us find our number bonds to 20.

After half term we will be looking at length and height, place value to 50 and weight and mass.

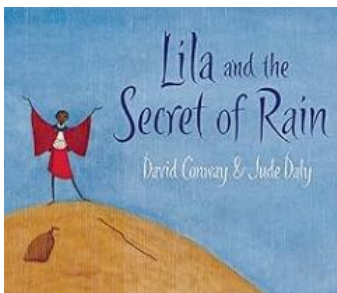
Lots of counting and working out what number is one less than 50? What number is one more than 40?

English

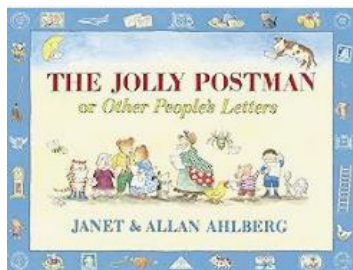
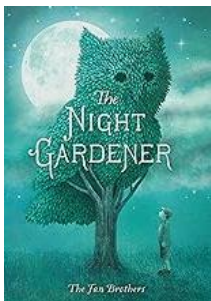
We will be retelling the story of Tidy.
