







Welcome	Maths

We will be learning the 3, 4 and 8 times table. We will move onto learning how to multiply using the coloumn method and how to divide using the bus stop method.</p> <p>Our next unit is measurement (length and perimeter). We will be measuring in centimetres, millimetres and metres. We will be adding and subtracting lengths and measuring and calculating perimeter.</p> <p>Our next unit is fractions. We will be learning about numerators, denominators and how to count in fractions.</p>

<p>We will be creating a sequel to 'The Barnabus Project' in term 3.</p>  <p>We will be learning about subordinating conjunctions, prepositional phrases, apostrophes for possession and inverted commas.</p> 	<p>In Science, we will be learning about magnets, states of matter and the water cycle in term 3. In term 4, we will be learning about organisms and ecosystems. In Geography, we will be learning about contrasting localities. In History, we will be learning about Ancient Egypt. In RE, we will be learning about Christianity, the Gospels and the Easter story. In PSHE, our topics are Dreams and Goals and Healthy Me. In PE, we will be improving our tennis and hockey skills whilst looking at symmetry, asymmetry and wild animals. In Music, we will be learning about pitch.</p>
<p>In term 4, we will be writing a setting description based on 'Lost and Found' and writing a persuasive letter based on 'The Day the Crayons Quit'.</p> 	<h3>Reminders</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Indoor PE will be on a Friday afternoon and outdoor PE will be on a Wednesday afternoon. • Please make sure your child brings a water bottle to school. Water only; no squash or juice please. • The school policy on snacks is to ensure that they should be a healthy option. If you would like your child to have a mid-morning snack, we encourage them to bring in fresh fruit or vegetables. Please do not send in any foods containing nuts. • Book bags should be brought to school every day. Planners will also be checked every week.
