We think it will be helpful for you to have a list of things that your child will need for the field study visit to Barton Camp.

- 🕒 Torch (for night time toilet visits)
- 🕒 Camera if desired; each child will be entirely responsible for care of this so disposable camera may be best
- 🕒 Large and small towel
- 🕒 Wash bag
- 🕒 Books and comics, games etc for free time (no electrical equipment)
- 🕒 Spending money up to £10.00
- 🕒 A small amount of sweets, chocolate
- 🕒 Plastic flask / sealable container for taking drinks out
- 🕒 Plastic mug for squash at camp
- 🕒 Soft shoes, slippers or daps for indoors (but not big animal slippers please!)

## Lower Level

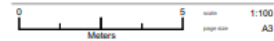

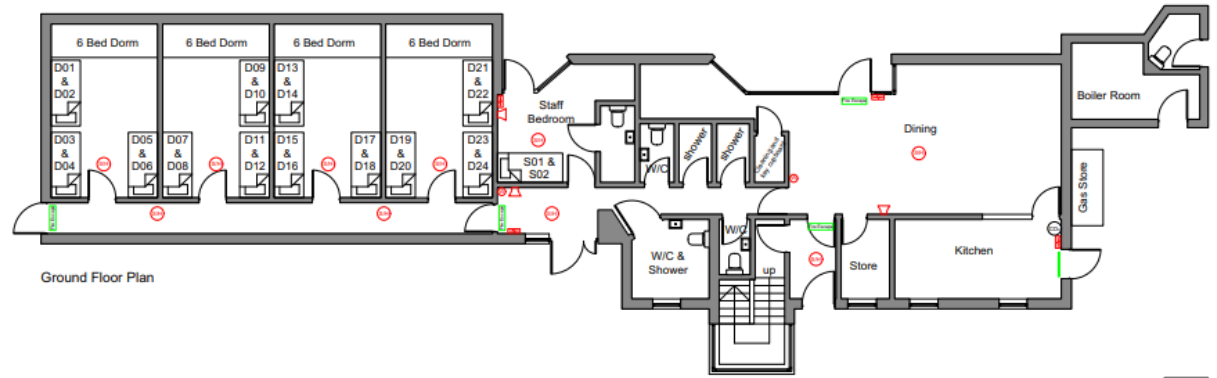

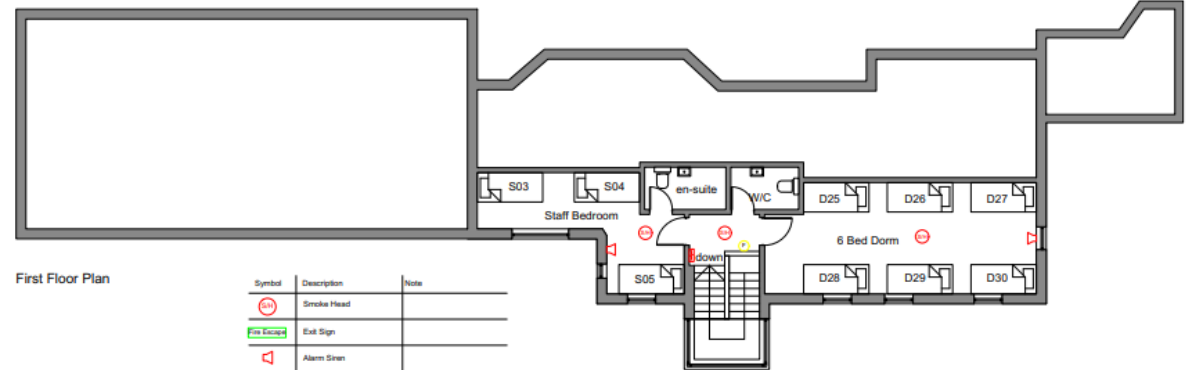
