If children are unhappy they can speak to ChildLine 0800 1111

Everyone working with our children, their parents and carers should be aware:

- Their role is to listen and note carefully any observations which could indicate abuse
- They should not attempt to investigate once the initial concern is raised
- They should involve the DSL immediately
- If the DSL is not available, the deputy DSL should be contacted
- Disclosures of abuse or harm from children may be made at any time
- If there are any concerns about a member of staff, this must be shared with the DSL
