### **School Lunches**

We are very proud of the way our Reception children have settled into school.

During the week commencing 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2019, the children will be staying for the morning session, Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday 9 – 12 Middy, then on **Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> and Friday 27<sup>th</sup>, they will stay to have their lunch at school, 9am – 1.10pm.**

We would like the children to start following the entry routine independently this week. If you are concerned about this please let us know.

### **Choice of School Dinner**

Every child has decorated a named peg which they will use to indicate their choice of dinner. They will put their peg on the appropriate coloured plate in the classroom.

The Red Plate is always the first choice of meal on the menu for that day. This is usually meat based.

The Green Plate is the Vegetarian option.

The Yellow Plate is for the children who will be bringing a packed lunch.

The orders for red or green lunches are taken at register time and the kitchen staff will only cook the amount of meals that have been asked for. If there are any changes to the menu we will let you know as soon as possible.

The children will be the first classes into the hall for lunch, giving them ample time to eat their meal. Teachers, Teaching Assistants, Playworkers and children from KS 2 will support the children throughout their meal time. The information you have provided about dietary needs has been passed to the kitchen staff and we monitor this very carefully. If you would like to discuss this in further detail with the school cook then please make an appointment through the school office to meet her. **Please inform us immediately if you have not provided us with this information.**

After lunch, on Thursday and Friday, the children will participate in playtime. The gates will open at 1.10pm. Please pick your child up from the classrooms following the normal routine.
