Mary Poppins Costumes

Dear Parents,

As you will have noticed, the children are getting very excited about our KS2 show 'Mary Poppins', which we started to rehearse this week. The production will be performed at the end of the term on the 18th (morning and evening) and 19th December (evening). As usual, each of the junior classes has a song to perform in the show. Class NB will be singing the song '**Chim-Chim-Cheree**'.

The children will be playing chimney sweeps so we would be very grateful if you could provide the following items for the costume:

- **Plain long sleeve shirt with collar cut off (white, blue, grey, cream or any other dark colour would be best)**
- **Dark trousers (school grey would be fine, or black, dark blue or brown)**
- **Red neckerchief (any piece of fabric would be fine)**
- **A dark waistcoat if possible**
- **A flat cap**
- **Black shoes (not trainers)**

If you are happy to put any black smudges on the clothes, that would add to the authenticity! We will be making some simple sweeps' brushes at school.

We would like to put some smears of black face paint on the children's faces. Please let us know if your child is allergic to this or if for any other reason you would prefer them not to have this.

In the past, support from parents has been invaluable and we really appreciate the effort that goes into the children's costumes.

We would be most grateful if you could provide your child with their costume. Please could your child bring in their costume into school on **Monday 9th December** on a named hanger please.

Please do not hesitate to come and see me if you have any difficulties with the costume.
