Dear Parents and Carers

The Theatre Royal has very kindly organised discounted tickets for the Pantomime this year following last year's visit. We will be visiting on Thursday 9th January 2020. The children always greatly enjoy this visit to the theatre and wearing fancy dress makes it a very special occasion. This year the pantomime is 'Beauty and The Beast'.

We know that some parents take children to see the pantomime as a family. We do feel that going with their school friends is a very different experience and no two panto performances are ever the same!

The school links curriculum activities, such as writing playscripts in English, with this visit so there is also an element of learning with this fun New Year activity.

The ticket prices this year have been heavily discounted by the Theatre Royal and we are very grateful for this generosity. The cost for the ticket and coach journey to and from the Theatre will be £17.35. No child will be refused a place on the grounds that their parents do not wish to make a financial contribution, but unless a substantial number of parents wish their children to take part and are willing to make a contribution, we will be unable to run the trip. Arrangements will be made for children whose parents do not wish them to attend.
