Dear Parent/Carers

We are living in unprecedented times at the moment and as such, changes have been made to the way we carry out usual school business. Unfortunately, due to the timing of the school closure and the possibility that we may not be back for any length of time in the Summer Term, we have decided to send out reports (in line with the other schools in the WMAT) summarising your child's achievements so far this year and giving an indication (as we did at Parents Consultation Evenings) of their year with us so far, as well as their attainment against year group expectations. These are based upon the work your child was producing in class before the school was closed, as well as standardised assessments for the Spring Term and were reported to you by your child's class teacher when you met them. They have been assigned one of the following descriptions for reading, writing and maths:

- Working significantly below EXS (this means your child is working below their year group expectations and will already have been discussed with you)
- Working towards EXS (this means your child is working just below the level expected of their year group)
- On track to meet EXS (this means your child is working at the level expected of their year group)
- On track to exceed EXS (this means your child is working at greater depth against the year group expectations)

*EXS = Expected standard for the year group.*

We have included targets for your child to work on, which we know parents have found useful in the past. We have tried to make them achievable given the current circumstances.


