I am writing to ask for your help in strengthening the measures we have in place to help minimise risks.


We ask that you continue to follow these guidelines:

3. Please do not position yourself in the entrances so other parents breach social distancing to access the pick-up points.

To give further reassurance and to add another layer of protection to parents, staff and children, we would like to request that from Monday 12th October, face coverings are worn (unless you are exempt from this) by adults dropping off and picking up children and visiting the school site. We are unable to enforce this as you know but we hope you respect our request. Staff will also wear masks at this time and will also be wearing them outside their designated classroom when inside the building.
