Dear Parents/Carers

I am delighted to let you know that we can now officially invite you to watch the Year 6 leavers' service on Wednesday 21st July - this will begin at 9:15am prompt.

Please also see the attached letter we sent out on the 28th June with useful reminders as to what Year 6 need to bring in, and when, so that their final day goes smoothly. Please note the sign-in arrangements for the service have been amended (as detailed below). We do plan to film events this week just in case our Year 6 "bubble" pops - we really do hope it doesn't.

As we are still socially distancing within the restrictions of the hall, there will be an allocation of **one invitation per family** and masks must be worn throughout the performance (unless exempt).

The running time is approximately 45 minutes.

The children should wear their Leavers' T-shirt and black/grey skirt/trousers and school shoes for the performance.

Please can we ask that whoever is attending the performance takes a lateral flow test before they attend school. We know that this is not a guarantee, but there is of course a risk associated with having adults on our site. You will have a named seat - so should track and trace contact us it is important that whoever attends provides accurate contact information using the Microsoft form [here](#) so I can contact you should we receive a positive notification. We completely understand that you may not wish to take this risk and we will of course be making sure all the film footage etc is released on the Wednesday morning via our school website for those families not attending.

Please take into consideration that should we have any infection on site - especially in Year 6 - we may have to change or cancel our arrangements at very short notice. Apologies for this.

We look forward to seeing many of you next Wednesday.
