We are delighted to have the opportunity to join the EYFS classes from Two Rivers, Chandag Infants, The Meadows and St John's for an EYFS Singing Festival on **Tuesday 1st April 2025 at Two Rivers School**. The festival runs within the school day, from 9.30am- 11.00am.

This musical extravaganza will be led by Ingrid McLean, Director of Music for Futura Learning Partnership and promises to be a joyful morning of collaboration, song and celebration with our local family of schools.

On the day, we would be grateful if parents could drop their children to Two Rivers School Fairfield Way, Keynsham, Bristol BS31 1GE at 9.15am to be registered. The parking around Two Rivers is very limited so we have contacted Waitrose who have kindly allowed us to offer their carpark with parents walking their children up to the school from there. We appreciate this doesn't always fit in with working patterns so it would be really helpful if, in the first instance, parents could support each other with the drop off. If this is still an issue for you, please do let us know and we will do our best to support you. If this is a day that you use Chuckles Breakfast Club, please advise us on the [form attached](#) and we will organise your child's transport for the morning.

The festival ends at 11.00am and we will be walking the children back from Two Rivers ready for their lunch time. We would be grateful for as many parents/ grandparents who can spare the time to walk back with us. Please indicate if you are available on the [attached form](#). On this day, the children will be able to order a packed lunch from the kitchen as opposed to a cooked meal, to ensure food is available on their return. Please indicate [on the form](#) whether your child would like a ham or cheese sandwich, any dietary requirements or whether you will choose to send your child to school with their own packed lunch.

As you will be aware, school budgets are tight and so we are asking for a voluntary donation of £1 per child to go towards the running of this event, including a snack (all dietary requirements will be considered) and drink for each child and resourcing. If you wish your child to take part, **please make your payment via MCAS by Monday 17th March**. No child will be refused a place on the grounds that their parents do not wish to make a financial contribution, but unless a substantial number of parents wish their child to take part and are willing to make a contribution, the visit will have to be cancelled. If needed, arrangements will be made for the children whose parents do not wish them to take part.

This is such an exciting opportunity that we are delighted to be part of. The children will be practicing the songs ready for this event in the run up and we will share highlights of this with you via Tapestry.
