Year 4 Health Education and Camp meetings Monday 7th March 2022

We would like to invite you to an information evening regarding our Year 4 Health Education (sex and relationships education), followed by the Year 4 Camp meeting.

These meetings will take place on **Monday 7th March 2022**. The Health Education meeting will begin at 6.15 pm in Willow classroom and the Camp meeting at 7.00 pm in the hall. If we are unable to meet in person, we will hold the meetings on Zoom and will contact you with the necessary details.

As you may be aware, we deliver our Personal, Social and Health Education (PSHE) learning using a scheme of work called Jigsaw. In term 6 all classes will have lessons delivered from a theme called 'Changing Me'. This unit teaches from the now **statutory** RSHE (Relationships, Sex and Health Education) curriculum as discussed in our recent parents' forum.

This is a valuable part of every child's education and all will benefit from a clear programme of RSHE. We will be using Jigsaw to deliver these lessons. This scheme brings together PSHE, emotional literacy, social skills and spiritual development in a weekly lesson programme.

- The health education meeting will give an overview of the content and resources that we use to teach this essential subject.
- The camp meeting will outline the activities for the week, as well as what families will need to do to prepare for the trip.
