Dear Parents/Carers

KS1 Visit to Warleigh Lodge Farm

To support our 'Food and Farming' learning this term, all the children in Key Stage One have the opportunity to visit Warleigh Lodge Farm for a day's learning about food and farming. The children will learn about the day-to-day running of a farm, visit and feed the animals, participate in harvest activities and navigate their way round the farm.

Class RHSEH will visit on Thursday 7th October

Class NJ will visit on Friday 8th October

Class MN will visit on Wednesday 13th October

Class CE will visit on Thursday 14th October

We will leave school at 9.15am and will return to school by 3.15pm. Drop off and pick up times will be unaffected.

The cost of this trip will be £12.60. No child will be refused a place on the grounds that their parents do not wish to make a financial contribution, but unless a substantial number of parents wish their children to take part and are willing to make a contribution, we will be unable to run the trip. Arrangements will be made for children whose parents do not wish them to attend. Payment must be made on-line using School Gateway. 1. Your permission for your child to attend the visit
2. Whether you are able to be a parent helper. Parents whose names are drawn will be informed **by Tuesday 28th September** by your child's class teacher. Parents should hold a DBS with the school to volunteer for this visit.
3. Selection for lunch. As infant children receive free school meals, your child is entitled to a free packed lunch provided by the school kitchen on this day. Please indicate which sandwich choice you would like for your child or if your child will be bringing his/her own packed lunch from home.

On the appropriate day children will need to wear their school jumper, appropriate warm outdoor trousers, a warm, waterproof coat and comfortable shoes or trainers. In addition to this, they will need to bring a pair of wellies and spare pair of socks that they can change into. It is really important that this is provided in a separate CARRIER BAG and not the only


footwear that your child brings to school on this day. If you are using the wellington boots that are kept at school, please ensure you have organised this before the day of the trip. All children will need a rucksack to carry their things in and please send your child with a full water bottle and snack.


