Music Project: Year Four and Five

We are delighted to invite your child to be part of Futura's first collaborative musical event – The Futura Oratorio! Futura have commissioned a local composer, Phil Dixon, to write a piece of music for two junior choirs, a senior choir and orchestra, which we will perform at Bath Forum on Tuesday 19th July.

Our composer, Phil Dixon will visit each school to work with them during Terms 5 and 6 during the school day. On Monday 18th July all singers and musicians will spend the day rehearsing – it will be an exciting day in which we start to put the whole 40 minute piece together. The following day, Tuesday 19th July, we will descend on Bath Forum, rehearse for the day and then perform in front of family, friends and the Futura Learning Partnership community. We anticipate that this performance will start at 6.30pm, but will confirm this nearer the time.

At Futura we sincerely believe that music is for everyone, and we want this to be a magical experience for all the children involved in the project. This could be a transformational moment in some children's lives – experiencing the joy of making music with others (all our trust schools, secondary and primary are involved in the project) and performing in such a unique venue.

The transport for the children will be organised by us and is fully funded. Tickets will be free and we will organise the collection of these nearer the time. My understanding as this is such a huge venue – is that we will have plenty of tickets available. We would need you to collect your child from the Forum at the end of the performance.
