Cake Baking Rules and Guidelines

Theme: Paris Olympics

The rules for Salford Schools 2024 Bake Off are:

- All entries must be from children attending Salford School, one entry per category either as a single entry and/or team entry within their year group only.
- Entry to the competition is free and the theme is the **2024 Paris Olympics**
- No restriction on recipe used but all items must be homemade and contain **NO NUTS**
- Each entrant must fill out an entry form including the list of ingredients and ensure it accompanies their baked item. Entries containing **NUTS** will be disqualified.
- Entries must be dropped off by 9am on **Friday 14th June** in the Library. Baked items will not be accepted after this time

The theme for the bake off is the **2024 Paris Olympics**, children are encouraged to be as inventive and creative as they like.

Categories are:

- **Reception – Biscuits**
- **Years 1 – 2 Cupcakes**
- **Years 3 – 4 Tray Bake**
- **Years 5 – 6 Celebration Cake**

Entries will be judged on: **Theme/Overall Presentation/Texture/Taste**

All baked items will be judged by **Sally Turner** and **Headteacher Dawn Sage** on Friday 14th June 2024. **The judge's decision is final.** Judging will take place prior to the fair, with the winning entries announced at around 2pm at the Summer Fair taking place on Saturday 15th June 2024.

Winning entries will be notified by mobile phone and additional details given for timings around the prize giving. The winners will be required to accept their prizes and be willing to be photographed by the PTA for purposes of being used in the school newsletter/school social media.

Any cake stands/plates used to display your cakes need to be named and can be collected after the fair from the tearooms or from the library on Monday 17th June.

All non-winning cakes will be sold in the tearooms or used in the cake tombola to raise valuable funds for the school. The winning cake will be raffled off.

Each winner and runner up will be presented with a certificate and gift by **Dawn Sage**. The prizes will be awarded as follows:

Reception winner and runner up
Year 1 – 2 winner and runner up
Year 3 – 4 winner and runner up
Year 5 – 6 winner and runner up
