As a family, we understand that there are many types of technology, including tablets, games consoles and phones.

We will use our computers and the internet safely and sensibly as part of a range of leisure activities.

When I use any computer, I will be SMART:

S **SAFE** Keep safe by being careful not to give out personal information – such as your full name, email address, phone number, home address, photos or school name – to people you are chatting with online.

M **MEETING** Meeting someone you have only been in touch with online can be dangerous. Only do so with your parents' or carers' permission and even then only when they can be present.

A **ACCEPTING** Accepting emails, IM messages, or opening files, pictures or texts from people you don't know or trust can lead to problems – they may contain viruses or nasty messages!

R **RELIABLE** Information you find on the internet may not be true, or someone online may be lying about who they are.

T **TELL** Tell your parent, carer or a trusted adult if someone or something makes you feel uncomfortable or worried, or if you or someone you know is being bullied online.

I will ask an adult if I want to use a type of technology.

If I have a username or password I will keep it safely within my family or my teacher.

I will check with a trusted adult if I am on the internet and want to go on a different site.

I will tell a trusted adult if I think that one of my friends is not keeping the Golden Rules with the technology that we use.

I will be polite, kind and caring online.

I know that my parents/teachers will check what I have been doing on our computers/the internet.

I know that if I break the rules I might not be allowed to use the computers.
